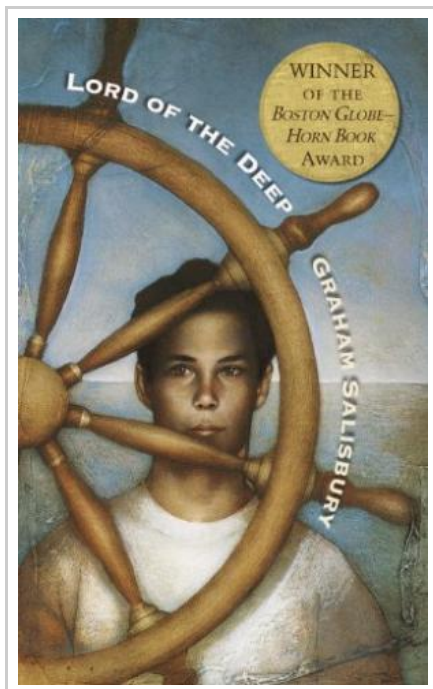




Lord of the Deep (Paperback)
