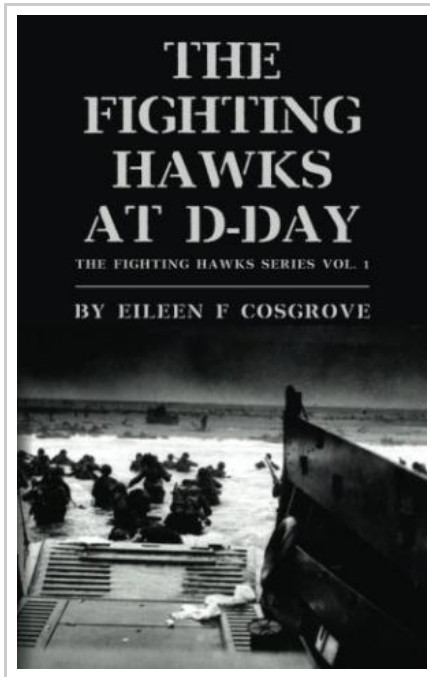




The Fighting Hawks at D-Day Volume 1
