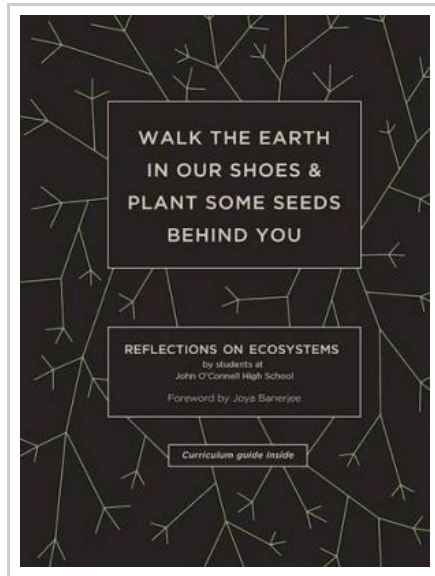




Walk the Earth in Our Shoes and Plant Some Seeds Behind You (Paperback)
